Eligibility requirements:

- Live in the city of Detroit (verified by mailing address) and graduate from high school in 2020 or after, OR graduate from any [Detroit high school](#) (public, private, charter, parochial, home school or GED program) in 2020 or after
- Be admitted to Wayne State University as a first-time, full-time freshman in fall 2023
- WSU must receive your 2023-24 [FAFSA](#) by March 1, 2023.
- Must be admitted to WSU by March 1, 2023
- Awards will be given until funding is exhausted

Continued eligibility requirements:

- Meet all [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#) requirements
- Maintain full-time enrollment (12 or more credit hours each semester) during the fall and winter semesters
- Pass at least 30 credits per academic year
- Submit an updated FAFSA by August 1 for the next academic year
