

## REQUIRED: WSU Dependent Eligibility Types and Supporting Documentation

The chart below shows each category of an eligible dependent as defined by Wayne State University's Medical Plan and lists examples of supporting documentation that you are required to submit along with the completed form.

	Dependent Type	Supporting Documentation Category
1.	Legal Spouse*	Page 1 of the most current year's Income Tax Form 1040 verifying marital status (please mark out any financial information). <b>For dates of marriage in 2011 only – a copy of marriage certificate is required.</b>
3.	Other Eligible Person (OEP); age 26 or older	Proof of shared residence for 18 months (examples include: copy of lease/mortgage; financial documents; utility bill or other paperwork); <b>and</b> a copy of Driver's License showing address same as WSU employee
<b>CHILDREN UNDER AGE 27</b>		
4.	Children of Employee or Spouse by Birth or Adoption	Birth Certificate or adoption paperwork showing you or your spouse as the parent
5.	Children of Employee or Spouse under legal guardianship	A copy of court documents indicating guardianship by employee or legal spouse.
6.	Principally Supported Children (not employees children by birth or marriage) through the end of the year they reach age 19	Page 1 of the most current year's Income Tax form 1040 listing dependent as a deduction (please mark out any financial information)
<b>CHILDREN 27 AND OLDER</b>		
7.	Unmarried disabled dependent children	Birth certificate showing you or your spouse as the child's parent; <b>and</b> proof of continued incapacitation of child
<b>OTHER DEPENDENTS</b>		
8.	Sponsored Dependent; age 26 or older	Page 1 of the most current year's Income Tax form 1040 listing dependent as a deduction (please mark out any financial information)
9.	Senior Rider; age 65 or older	Page 1 of the most current year's Income Tax form 1040 listing dependent as a deduction (please mark out any financial information)

\* If you are divorced or legally separated, your former spouse is ineligible for Wayne State University's Medical Plan coverage
